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Fun Poinsettia


Fabric Requirements:
Gray: (4) $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
White: (4) $6^{\prime \prime} \times 10$
Blue: (4) $7^{\prime \prime} \times 77^{\prime \prime}$
(4) $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$


Stack gray fabric. Make a mark 1/2" in from corners (sample blue arrows). Place QCR over fabric so the curve cut out is lined up over marks. Make your cut. Set aside curved pieces.


Stack white fabric. Make a mark 6 " in from each corner on 10 " sides (sample red arrows). Place QCR over fabric so the curve cut out is lined up over upper left corner and 6 " mark along bottom edge. Make your cut.


Rotate ruler. Place QCR over fabric so the curve cut out is lined up over bottom right corner and $6 "$ mark along top edge. Make your cut.


Stack and cut 7"x 7" blue squares in half diagonally. Cut $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ off triangle points (sample white circles).


Set aside corner curve pieces, discard inner curve pieces.


Set aside corner curved shapes. Discard center piece.


Place QCR over fabric so the curve cut out is centered over inner corner points (sample red arrows). Make your cut.


Layout curved stacks as shown above for sewing.


Sew curved pieces together with bottom piece extending a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ past top piece as shown above.


Square up block to a $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Place QCR over block centering the $51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ marks over seams (sample red arrows)


Use the blue
$51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares for corners for poinsettia block. Layout blocks to form flower. Sew blocks to form rows. Sew rows to form flower.
